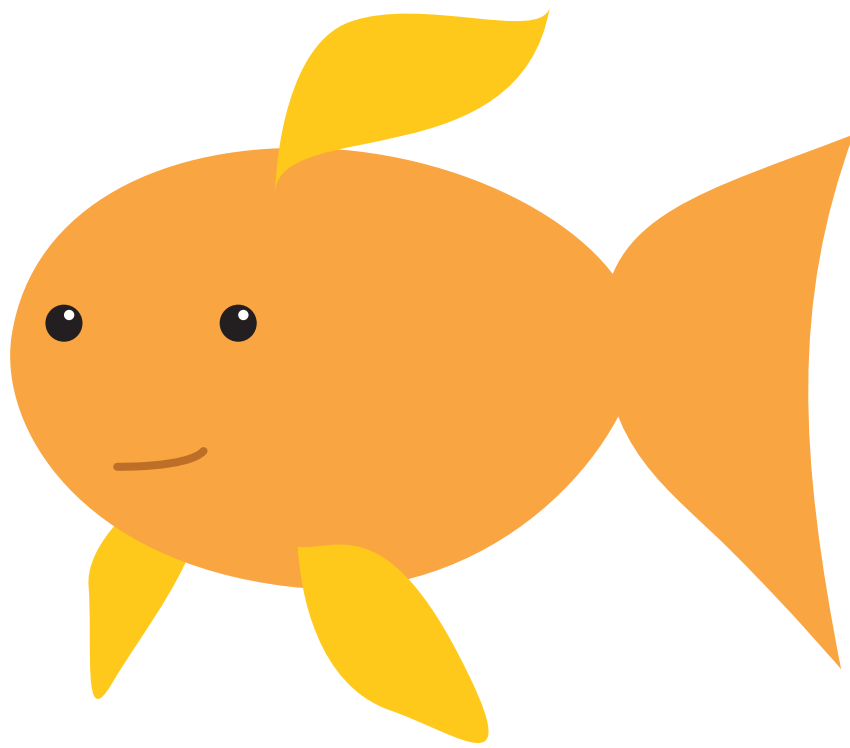


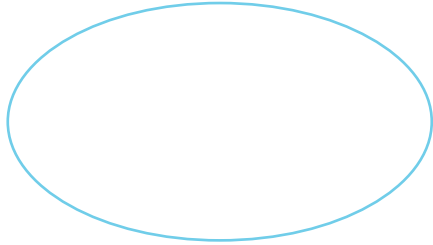

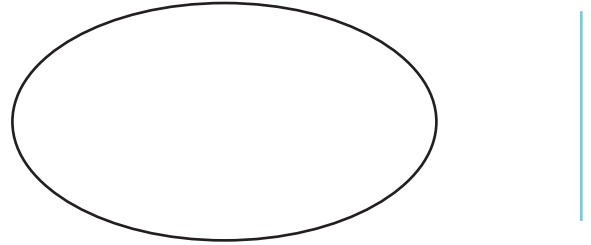


How to draw a fish

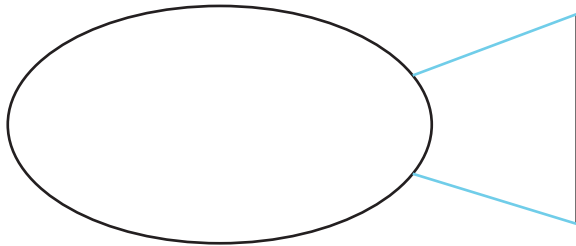
1. Draw an oval.



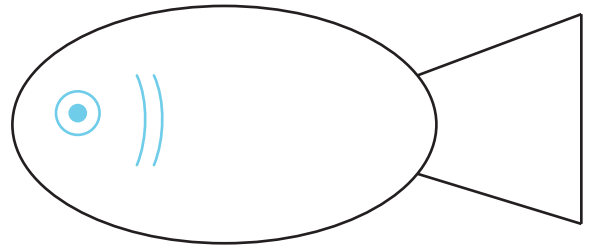
2. Draw a line for the edge of the tail.



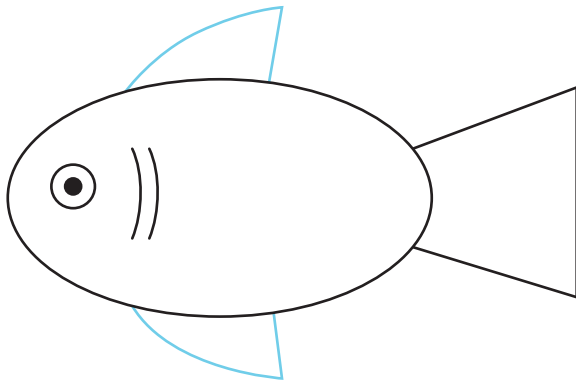
3. Connect the lines to the body.



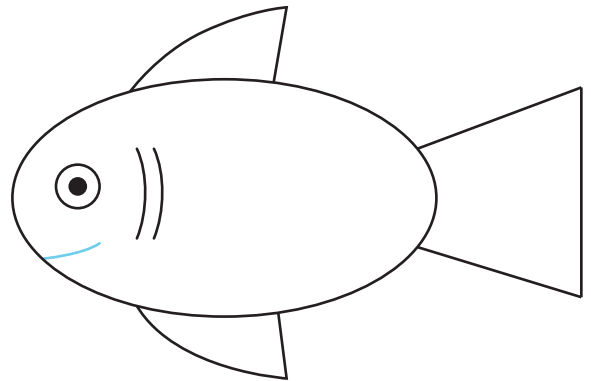
4. Draw an eye and gills.



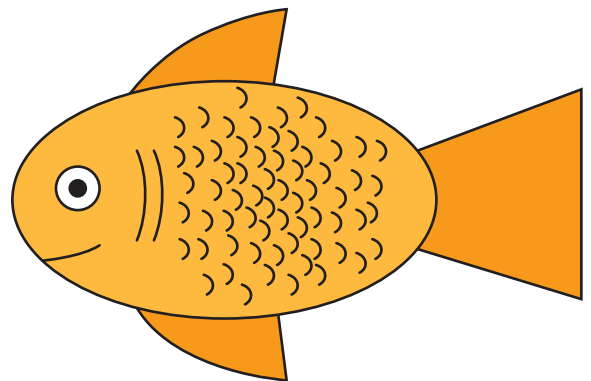
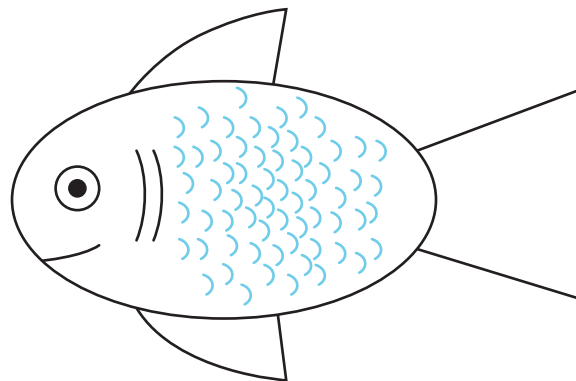
5. Draw lines to make the fins.



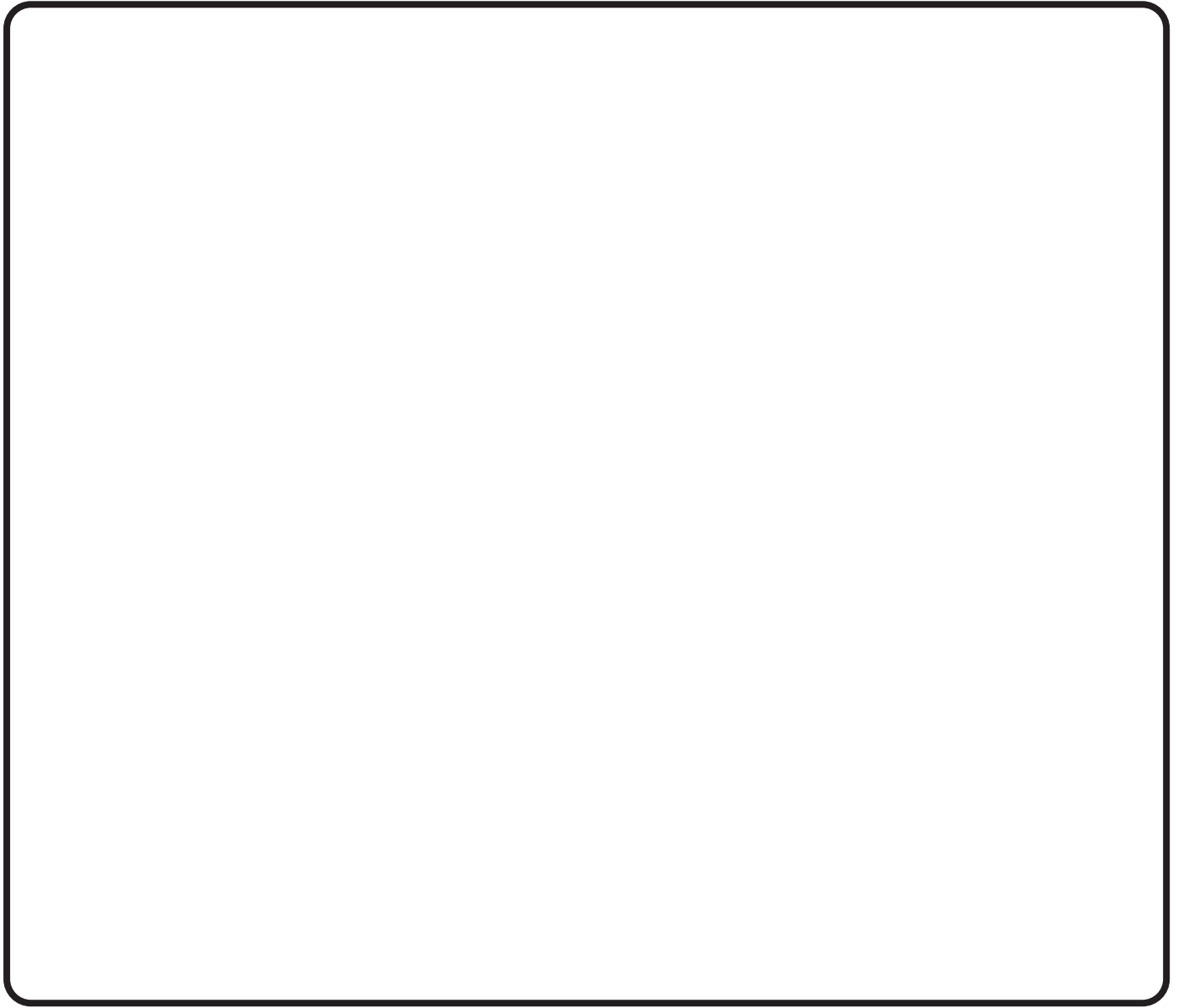
6. Add a line for the mouth.
